Arena Cafe at the venue is open from Thu, 21.05 – Sun, 25.05 and Wed 27.05 – Sun 31.05 on the expense of the Athletes.

Showers are located near stable area.

SHUTTLE SERVICE AND TRANSPORTATION

If you need any kind of help with transportation, please turn to the Show Office.

ENTRY TO THE STABLES

Entrance bracelets will be distributed as follows:

1 bracelet to the rider // 1 bracelet to the groom // 1 bracelet to the athlete's partner // 1 bracelet to the owner of each horse (2 owners per horse max, according to the official Master List)
Bracelets will be given out at the Show Office upon arrival. **Only persons with bracelets are allowed to the stables.**

SHOW OFFICE

Show Office is located near the main and warm-up arena.
Show office opens at 17:00 on 20.05 for first and at 10:00 on 27.05 for second week.

ARRIVAL AND ACCOMMODATION OF HORSES

Horses are accommodated at the expense of the OC from 16:00 20.05 till 31.05

Competition days Stables are open:

06:00-22:30

**AFTER STABLES CLOSING PLEASE NO NOISE IN STABLE AND PARKING AREA
PENALTY 100€ PER INCIDENT**

Stabling includes initial bedding (shavings).
To buy additional bedding please purchase the voucher from Show Office prior to contacting the stable manager. Shavings are available in the stable area between **8:00-9:00 & 16:00-17:00.**

If necessary, outside these times, please call Stable Manager.

Shavings - 20 EUR per bag // Hay - 10 EUR per bale // Electricity 100 EUR per lorry
Payment at the Show Office at the time of settling the accounts.

In order to facilitate the arrival of horses, the time and date and the means of transport should be sent to the stable manager's email

She can also answer your questions about stabling at the venue.

Electricity requests also need to be done with FEI entries.

PLEASE NOTE:

- **All manure must be dropped in the designated area at the stables.**
- **It's forbidden to smoke in the stables / stabling area or bring alcoholic beverages to the stables / stabling area.**
- **All dogs must be kept on a leash!**

If violations are noticed by the stable manager, any officials or OC members, the OC can demand a fine up to € 100 per offence.

VETERINARY

It is necessary to take the horse's temperature daily morning and evening during the competition period and register it in the FEI HorseApp.

PLEASE DO NOT FORGET! And bring your own thermometer!

You also must submit the Horse Health Self-Certification Form on the FEI HorseApp.

HORSE INSPECTION

Horse inspection will take place both weeks in Warm-up arena.

First week: 21.05 at 12:00 – 14:00

Second week: 27.05 at 18:00 – 20:00

All horses taking part at the CSI must be presented during the first horse inspection.

Please **bring your horse's passport to the show office in good time BEFORE the horse inspection.**

Competing horses must wear their bridle numbers at all times outside the stable.
